














Mr. Noisy was a very noisy person indeed.

Mr Noisy decided that he had to go shopping



That evening Mr Bumb was just standing there and she ran off with his bandage


And bandaged up Mr. Small

TWEAK! Somebody she couldn't see tweaked her nose


On Tuesday Mr Busy was rushing along She was going to trip him-


And he hit poor Mr Small

That evening Dr. Makeyouwell strolled over to see Mr. Small.


He then strolled over to see Miss Trouble You know what you've just had, don't you? "A taste of your own medicine" he chuckled
