






RICHIE BALANCE

Rockin' Richie Ray was four years old when he first heard

Gene Vincent singing "Be-Bop-A-Lula." He immediately
discarded his corduroy playsuit for a leather jacket and was
soon expelled from Mother Goose Nursery school for organiizing protection rackets on the milk and cookies run. Having
become heavily involved in collecting baseball cards, Richie
later turned to crimer proper to support his five-pack-a-day
habit. Cured through attendance at Baseball Card Flippers
Anonymous meetings, he turned to his second love, rockabilly
music. His debut single is thus about his favorite subject, and
has been described by KROQ disc jockey Bob Sala as "the
greatest record of the last twenty years."



THE TEMPLE CITY KAZOO ORCHESTRA

Temple City Kazoo Orchestra leader David Humms graduated from the Berkeley Conservatory of Music in 1974 majoring in Kazoology. Returning to his native Temple City David decided that an organization was needed to protect and promote "this country's most maligned instrument" and formed the TCKO. Says David, "Although the kazoo looks easy to play, it is without a doubt the most difficult of all instruments to master properly."

RUBEN GUEVARA


Ruben Guevara was born on October 17, 1942 in East Los Angeles. His father, a musician from Mexico, came to L.A. on a tour, settled there and formed the world's largest mariachi band numbering 742 pieces. In order to hold a practice they had to rent the entire city of El Monte. Ruben started singing in junior high school and when he joined the feared Clanton 14th Street Gang, he was made minister of harmony. In 1974 he met Frank Zappa, formed Ruben and the Jets and recorded two albums for Mercury Records. Ruben hopes that his arrangement of the National Anthem becomes the definitive version of the song so that those folks attending sports events will dance in the aisles.

Gefilte Joe, whose real name is Chayam Lipschitz, spent thirtytwo years as a Certified Public Accountant before his son
departed for college, leaving behind his Silvertone guitar.
Retired and with lots of time on his hands, Chayam taught himself to play, claiming "I knew I could make better records than
that rock dreck like Black Shabus and Schticks!" Gefilte Joe
and the Fish can be seen playing nightly except Friday at the
Whisky Shalom Theatre.



WILD MAN FISCHER

Wild Man Fischer, the Vladimir Horowitz of street singers, returned to the music scene after a long hiatus with this debut on the Rhino label. In England top BBC disc jockey John Peel received enough listener requests to place this record on his All Time Top 50. With this encouragement Wild Man thought the time right to record his second LP "Wildmania" for Rhino. These days Wild Man can be seen singing at Dodger Stadium, left field pavilion leading a flock of young baseball fans like a modern day Pied Piper.



LITTLE STEVIE WEINGOLD

Little Stevie Weingold was elected three times "Young Jewish Man Of The Year" by his AZA in Sherman Oaks and is a sixteen year old singer-songwriter. While skeptical of rock's more reckless qualities, he recorded "Be True To Your Shul" in a move he hopes will "instill some pride in our religion among the fallen teenage youth." He prays he'll make enough money from this song to devote his energies to pure Hebrew music. His first planned recording venture will be a three-disc set, live recording of his little brother's Bar Mitzvah.


THE CREDIBILITY GAP
